Scholarship Award

The ***Elyssa's Mission Scholarship Award*** was created to acknowledge and award high school seniors who have taken the initiative to successfully apply the core principles of the SOS program and make a difference in their school and/or community.

Scholarship Award Eligibility Criteria

All Loyola High School seniors who have successfully completed the *SOS Signs of Suicide program* are eligible.

Selection Criteria

- Essay
- Letter(s) of recommendation

Scholarship Awards

1 or 2 scholarship awards totaling \$1,500.00 may be awarded depending on the pool of applicants. Awards can be applied to tuition, books and supplies for community college, technical/vocational school or 4-year college/university.
